

Research Policy

Vision: To create a research-oriented ecosystem that fosters innovation, critical thinking, and academic excellence among students, faculty, and staff.

Mission: To promote research activities that align with the institution's goals and UGC guidelines, ensuring participation in conferences, seminars, research festivals, and publications.

Objectives:

1. Faculty Research:

- Encourage faculty to participate in conferences, seminars, and workshops (at least 2 per year).
- Support faculty research projects and publications (at least 1 publication per year).

2. Student Research:

- Encourage undergraduate, postgraduate, and Ph.D. students to participate in research festivals, conferences, and seminars (at least 1 per year).
- Support student research projects and publications (at least 1 publication per year).

3. Research Assistance:

- Provide financial assistance to students and faculty for paper presentations:
 - International: ₹5,000
 - National: ₹3,000

4. Collaboration and Partnerships:

- Foster collaborations with industry, academia, and research institutions.
- Establish memoranda of understanding (MoUs) with reputed organizations.

5. Research Ethics and Integrity:

- Ensure adherence to research ethics and integrity guidelines.
- Establish a research ethics committee to monitor and review research projects.

Implementation:

1. Research Cell: Establish a research cell to oversee research activities, funding, and documentation.
2. Research Committee: Constitute a research committee to review research proposals, monitor progress, and evaluate outcomes.
3. Research Mentorship: Assign faculty mentors to guide students in research projects.
4. Research Training: Provide research methodology training for faculty and students.

Monitoring and Evaluation:

1. Research Output: Monitor research output (publications, presentations, patents, etc.) annually.
2. Student Participation: Track student participation in research activities and festivals annually.

Revision and Update: Review and revise this policy biennially to align with changing UGC guidelines and institutional goals.
