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

### BY-LAWS

1. The by-laws shall formulate the rules and regulations to conduct the activities of AAN.
2. MANAGEMENT.
  - 2.1 All the activities of AAN shall be managed by a Managing Committee of the Association.
  - 2.2 The Managing Committee shall consist of not more than nine members of which the Principal of R. D. NATIONAL COLLEGE shall be the ex-officio chairperson.
  - 2.3 The first managing committee shall consist/comprise of the subscribers to the MEMORANDUM of Association.
  - 2.4 The term of the first managing committee shall be for a period of three years and their term shall expire on the third Annual General Meeting.
  - 2.5 The subsequent managing committee shall be for nominated by the ex-officio chairperson of which six members shall be from the teaching staff/faculty of R. D. NATIONAL COLLEGE and two members shall be from ex-students

### 3. FINANCE

- 3.1. The association shall maintain and operate a bank account.
- 3.2. The bank account may be operated by the secretary jointly with any one of the other four office bearers.
- 3.3. The Association will charge a membership fee as under :-

Ordinary membership	-	Rs. 200/- Annually Rs. 800/- For Five Years Rs. 1600/- For Ten Years
Life Membership	-	Rs. 4000/-
Patron membership	-	Rs. 10,000/- and above
Associate membership	-	Voluntary contribution

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3.4 The associative membership may get granted to any faculty /ex-faculty of R. D. NATIONAL COLLEGE.

3.5 All rights of accepting membership shall be reserved with the managing committee.

3.6 For all fund raising events undertaken, the dinner, tea-parties and social gatherings may be borne by the association or contributory in nature.

## 4. ACCOUNTS

4.1 The association shall maintain a regular account of its receipts and expenditure and shall prepare income and expenditure account and balance sheet at the end of every accounting year.

4.2 The accounting year shall commence from 1<sup>st</sup> April and shall end on 31<sup>st</sup> March every year. However, the first accounting year of the association shall be from the date of commencement i.e. 26<sup>th</sup> January, 2000 and shall end on 31<sup>st</sup> March, 2001.

4.3 A certified-charted accountant shall audit the accounts of every accounting year.

4.4 All the members of the managing committee shall sign the accounts of the association.

## 5. ADMINISTRATION

5.1 The managing committee shall publish by-annual newsletters to keep members informed about various activities of the association.

5.2 The managing committee shall comprise of President, Vice-President, Secretary and Treasurer who shall be selected by the members of the managing committee among themselves.

5.3 The managing committee may appoint various sub-committees to look after various project/activities undertaken by the association. However, the final decision in all matters shall be taken by managing committee.









**MEMORANDUM OF ASSOCIATION  
OF

**1. NAME**

The name of the association shall be "ALUMNI ASSOCIATION OF NATIONALITES" (hereinafter also referred to as AAN)

**2. REGISTERED OFFICE**

The registered office of the Association shall be situated at the premises of R.D. NATIONAL COLLEGE, Linking Road, Bandra(W), Mumbai - 400 050.

**3. AIMS & OBJECTS**

The aims and objects for which the association has been formed are as under: -

- vii) To organise and hold annual conference and dinner on the Founder's Day of the College and dinners, tea parties, social gatherings and other functions from time to time for the promotion and furtherance of the object of the Association and such dinners, tea parties and other functions, as the case may be, shall be either on a contributory basis or otherwise.
- viii) To honour the outstanding Alumni with lifetime Awards/Recognition's.
- ix) To raise resources for College Alumni activities and projects.
- x) To provide innovative methods to get professional inputs, from Alumni, in curricular, co-curricular and extra-curricular activities, of the College.
- xi) To provide appropriate infrastructure and status to the Alumni.
- xii) To provide a think-tank for strategic planning for academic excellence and inputs for long term goals.
- xiii) To expand and maintain the Library /Reading Room of R. D. National & W. A. Science College for the use of students and the staff of the College and to furnish the same with books, periodicals, reviews, magazines, newspapers and other publications.
- xiv) To print, publish, circulate, issue and exhibit any magazines, journals, periodicals, souvenirs, pamphlets or posters for the promotion of the objects of the Association.
- xv) To collect such text-books and other books as may be useful to the present students of R. D. National & W. A. Science College for the prosecution of their studies, and to the members of the Association, to be distributed at the



discretion of the Executive Committee, the books so collected remaining the property of the Association.

- xvi) To award prizes, bursaries and scholarships to the present as well as retiring staff of R. D. National & W. A. Science College with the approval of its Principal.
- xvii) To make donations &/or provide facilities for the benefit of the students and that of R. D. National & W. A. Science College.
- xviii) To solicit, invite, obtain, accept and receive any subscriptions, donations, grants, gifts, devices, bequests from any person whatsoever for the purposes of the Association/College provided that no subscriptions or donations shall be accepted if they are accompanied by conditions inconsistent or in conflict with the satisfactory running of the Association.
- xix) To accept and receive in any manner whatsoever any cash or immovable or movable property unconditionally in furtherance of any one or more of the objects of the Association.
- xx) To take such steps by personal or written appeals, exhibitions, public meetings, entertainment's or otherwise as may from time to time be deemed expedient for the purpose of procuring contributions to the funds of the Association in the shape of donations, legacies, annual payments or otherwise.
- xxi) Alumni, outside India, to be approached and a close liaison be established with them to make the aforesaid programmes successful.
- xxii) To build, construct and maintain houses or other buildings necessary or convenient for the purpose of the Association/College and alter, extend, improve, repair, enlarge or modify the same including the existing buildings and to provide and equip the same with light, water, drainage, furniture, fittings, instruments, apparatus and appliances and all other necessaries for the use to which each building is to be put up or held.
- xxiii) To acquire by gift, purchase, exchange, lease, on hire or otherwise howsoever any lands, buildings, tenements, rights of common, play-grounds, perks and any property movable and/or immovable and for any estate or interest for the furtherance of all or any of the objects of the Association/College.
- xxiv) To sell, manage, transfer, exchange, lease, mortgage, demise or otherwise dispose of any properties of the Association, movable or immovable.
- xxv) To execute conveyances, transfers, re-conveyances, mortgages, leases, bonds and agreements in respect of property, movable or immovable, belonging to the Association or to be acquired for the purposes of the Association/College.



- xxvi) To invest and deal with any money of the Association not immediately required for any of its objects in such manner as may from time to time be determined and to vary such investments.
- xxvii) To make rules and regulations for the conduct of meetings and affairs of the Association and to adapt and vary them from time to time.
- xxviii) To do all such necessary acts, deeds matters and things as an incidental or conducive to the attainment of any of the above objects.

#### 4. LIABILITY

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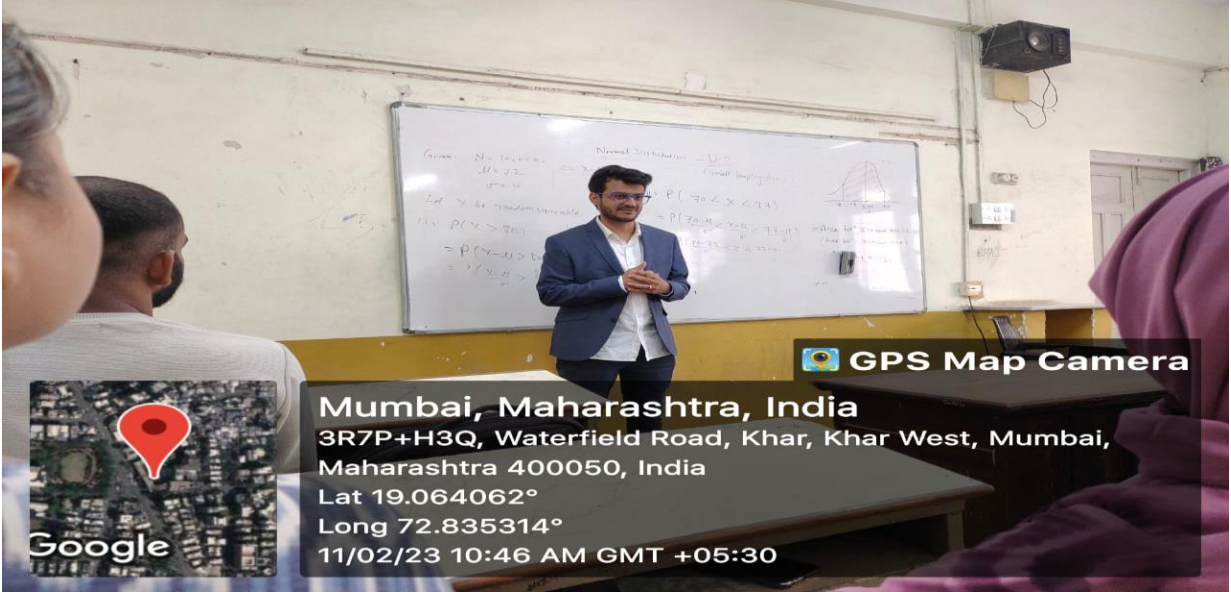

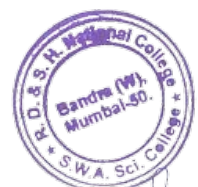
**Aim:** Career opportunities with BA/MA in English

He shared his own experience of working at the Max Planck Institute for Chemical Ecology, which is a renowned research institute in Germany.

The students were fascinated by Mr. Varma's experience and found the session to be very informative. The students found his insights on the differences between the research culture in India and Germany to be particularly useful.

Overall, the interaction with Mr. Varma was a great success and provided valuable information to the students. The students left the session feeling motivated and inspired, and many of them expressed their desire to pursue research in the future.

This letter is issued at the request of the assessee trust.

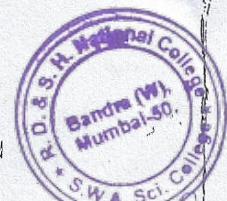

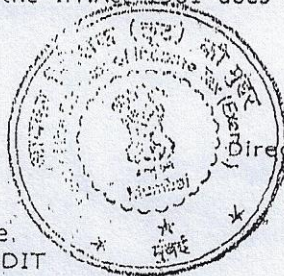
UNDER SECTION 80-G OF THE I. T. ACT  
(INITIAL/RENEWAL)

On verification of the facts stated before me/hearing before me I have come to the conclusion that this organisation has satisfied the conditions u/s.80-G of the I.T. Act, 1961. It shall henceforth satisfy the conditions u/s.80-G(5) as laid down below:

- v. Under the provisions of section 80-G any donation received shall not be utilised for the purpose of any such business carried on whether directly/indirectly.
- vi. While issuing the certificate to the Donor the commitment made above should be honoured and it shall not be abused/used in any other purpose.
- vii. The institution shall ensure that no Non-Charitable purpose shall be served or sought to be served by the Trust/Society/Non-Profit Company as is informed in terms of Yogiraj Trust reported in 107 ITR 777 (SC).
- viii. It shall be ensured that at no time you shall utilise the Institution or its funds for the benefits of any particular Religious community or caste prohibited u/s.80G(5)(iii).
- ix. This office and the Assessing Officer shall also be informed about the Managing Trustee/Manager of your Trust/Society/Non Profit Company and the place where the activities of the Trust/Institution are undertaken/likely to be undertaken to satisfy the claimed objects.
- x. In case Renewal is not sought from this office the manner in which the Assets shall be used/the purposes for which they shall be used shall be immediately informed to this office.
- xi. Religious expenditure should not exceed more than 5% of its total income.
- xii. The certificate u/s.80G of the I.T. Act 1961 does not automatically exempt the income of the Trust/Institution.

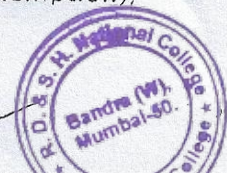
