

7.1.2 : Policy document on green campus/ plastic free campus

All the faculty members and students are liable for being aware of the environment impacts and for continually striving to minimize these impacts as set forth in this policy.

Green Campus Policy

- Reduce the energy usage and conserve energy.
- Reduce the water waste & recycle water
- Minimise use of paper for the purpose of internal communication whenever possible
- Devise mechanism for disposal of hazardous materials , chemicals and other substances
- Devise measure to segregate and manage waste generated inside the campus
- Involve the students in all kinds of activities and initiatives that help making our campus clean and green
- Promote awareness programmes to resolve environment issues
- Make stringent strategy to fix faults in electrical equipments and water taps without any delay
- Plant and maintain more indigenous plant species and spread awareness about them amongst society

Institutional Policy on use of Plastic in the Campus

- Discourage use of ‘single use plastic’ in the campus wherever possible to make the campus free from single use plastic
- No non-reusable plastic is to be used by any of the campus facilities including staff room, wash rooms, library and canteen
- Reuse old water bottles or purchase water bottles that one can refill instead of discarding a new bottle after single use
- Encourage the use of only glass, ceramic, steel cups, cutlery and containers
