The House System is an instrument of the college which focuses on the all-round development of the student. Apart from academics, House System ensures that the students tap on their hidden talent and potential.

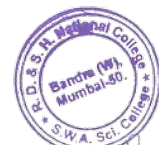

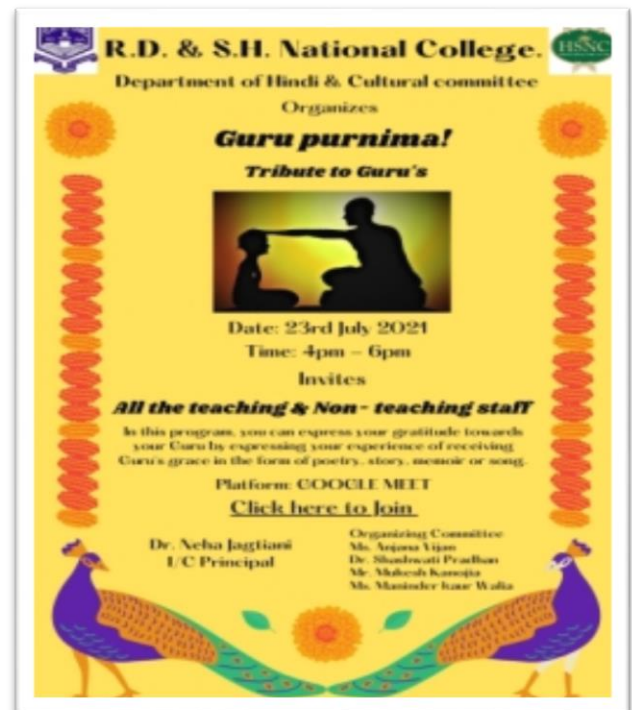
GURUPURNIMA

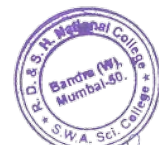

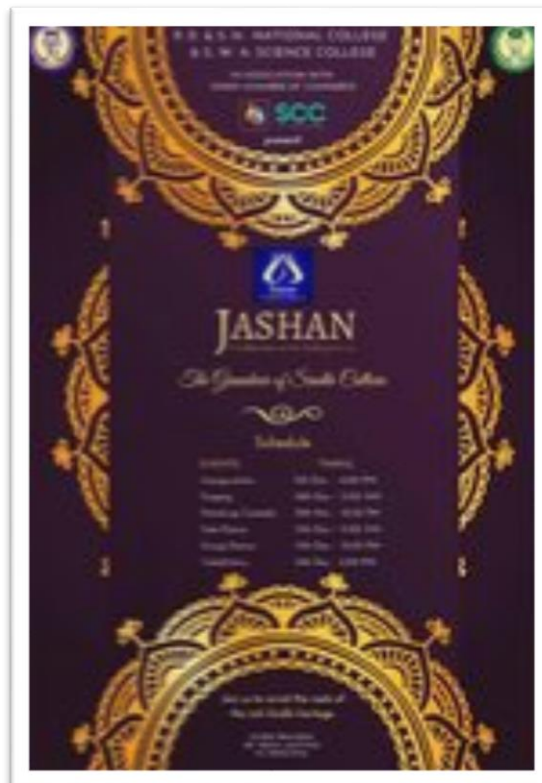

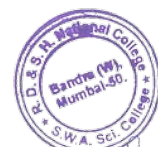

The event celebrated the festive spirit of Navratri, bringing together students, faculty, and members of the community for an evening filled with energetic dance, music, and cultural traditions.

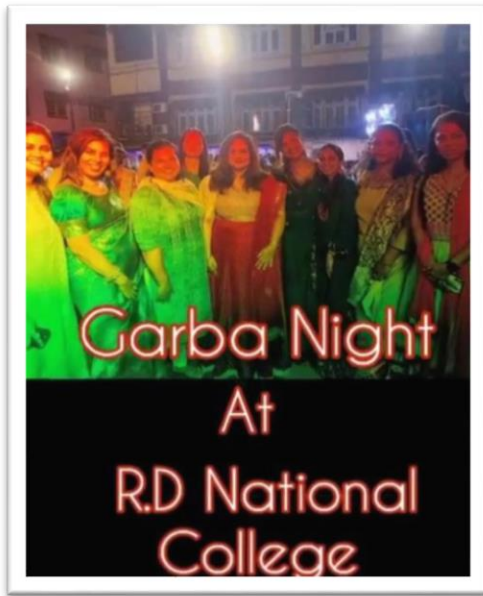

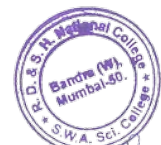

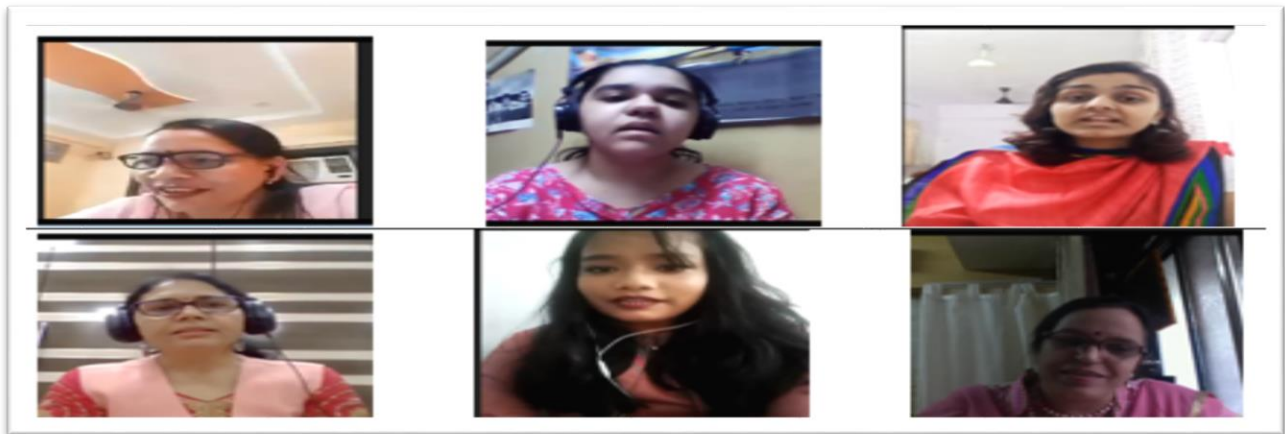
हिंदी विभाग का 'कवि सम्मेलन' संपन्न

MARATHI BHASHA DIWAS

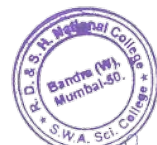

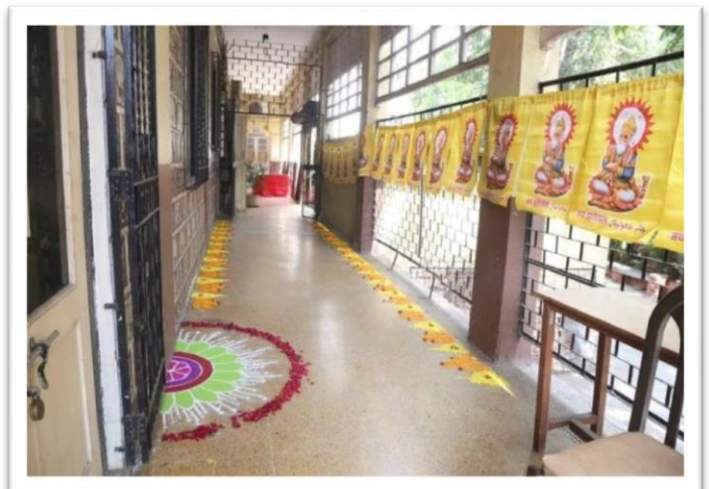

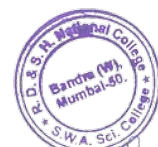

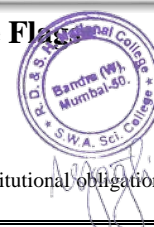
